Supplementing these studies will be an examination of the biological sciences of chemistry, physics, and various biology classes on human anatomy and physiology. These will afford you a more thorough understanding of how the body works and fights disease. Strong teamwork and communication skills will also be developed. By completion of the coursework you will have garnered extensive training and experience in the nursing profession, ranging from technical medical knowledge to actual patient interaction.
