

A bachelor's degree program is an undergraduate program that usually takes four years to complete. Enrolling in a bachelor's degree program requires that students choose a major area of study, such as finance, history, communications or biology.

Students in these programs learn effective ways to communicate visual messages using graphical elements including color, type, font, illustration and animation. Some programs also teach photography, Web design and printing techniques. Common courses include: Digital imaging, Multimedia production, Typography, Drawing 2-D and 3-D illustration, Motion graphics.
